

## SE Linwood Closed to Local Access Due to Pair of Projects

A pair of projects, one being performed by the City of Milwaukie, the other by Clackamas County Service District #1, will result in the closing of portions of SE Linwood Ave. to local access. Emergency vehicles and residents living immediately adjacent to the work zone will be allowed through.

SE Linwood will be closed from SE Harmony to SE Monroe for two weeks beginning May 10th due to Milwaukie's Linwood Avenue Paving Project. The grinding and preparation of the old surface will take about 3-4 days and the paving will take about 3-4 days. The grind will remove 2 to 5 inches to remove the road's high crown and will result in some abrupt edges during construction - so please be cautious. SE Linwood between SE Johnson Creek Boulevard and SE King Road is closed to through traffic until the end of June. This closure is needed to install sanitary sewer infrastructure as part of Clackamas County Service District #1's North Clackamas Revitalization Area (NCRA) sanitary sewer project.
