Water Environment Services Mission Statement

Water Environment Services (WES) provides citizen-supported, cost-effective, quality wastewater treatment and surface water management services.

Water Environment Services General Information

- WES is a department of Clackamas County that manages wastewater and / or stormwater in three districts within Clackamas County: Tri-City Service District, Clackamas County Service District No. 1 and the Surface Water Management Agency of Clackamas County.
- Serves more than 150,000 customers, providing wastewater management to seven cities and several unincorporated communities of Clackamas County, and surface water management to two county districts.
- Maintains over 261 miles of sanitary sewer lines and cleans six billion gallons of wastewater annually.
- Recycles more than 21 million gallons of biosolids annually.
- Operates five wastewater treatment plants: Tri-City Water Pollution Control Plant, Kellogg Creek Water Pollution Control Plant, Hoodland Sewage Treatment Plant, Boring Sewage Treatment Facility and Fischer's Forest Park Water Pollution Control System.
- Performs as the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) agent for on-site wastewater treatment.
- Functions as the County agent for the excavation and grading ordinance.

Surface Water Management Services

- Manage our stormwater assets
- Develop watershed-wide integrated stormwater management plans and programs
- Maintain the stormwater drainage system including pipes, detention ponds, structures, open channels and programs
- Design, prioritize, and conduct volunteer projects geared toward enhancing streamside environment
- Respond to customer service requests
- Ensure water quality/quantity permit obligations are met
- Monitor and track watershed health conditions and assess best management practices
- Provide development review and inspect and enforce erosion control

Communities and cities served by WES are: Boring, Clackamas, Damascus, Gladstone, Happy Valley, Hoodland, Johnson City, Milwaukie, Oregon City, Rivergrove and West Linn.

Wastewater Management Services

- Collect and treat wastewater
- Design, construct, and repair treatment plants and collection systems
- Issue permits to connect to sewer and constructs on-site wastewater treatment systems
- Administer local assessment districts
- Regulate and monitor industrial discharges
- Recycle treated wastewater and biosolids



Clackamas County Watershed Facts

- There are over 2,000 intermittent and perennial streams in Clackamas County.
- There are eight watersheds in Clackamas County: Abernethy, Clackamas, Kellogg, Johnson, Molalla, Pudding, Sandy and Tualatin.
- Populations of endangered or threatened species of Chinook Salmon, Coho Salmon, Steelhead and Cutthroat Trout can be found in Clackamas County's rivers and streams.
- WES works with citizens, volunteers and local groups to plant native vegetation along creeks and streams to help stabilize banks, create wildlife habitats, and filter sediments and other pollutants before they discharge and seep into the waterways.
