Old business :

1. Z0093-11 The approval of renewal of staff temp for care by Jean Fletcher was reviewed . It was noted that all of the renewals coming through now , contain the requirement for re-inspection of septic systems
2. Z0104-11-stc The approval of renewal of staff temp for care by Gene Lord was reviewed. All standard conditions and there was no discussion.

New Business;

1. Z0208-11-stc Application for renewal of staff temp for care by Pat O'Dell was reviewed and as all conditions were met, Betty made a motion to approve and Jason seconded. Vote #1 on the talley, 4 yes votes.
2. Z0243-11-stc Application for renewal of staff temp for care by George Ledbury was reviewed. all conditions were met so Jason made a motion for approval and it was seconded by Betty. vote #2 on the talley, 4 yes votes
3. The mailed invitation to the Molalla Communications annual meeting was discussed as it contained an appeal to members of Coltonel to encourage the board to enter into a joint venture with MCC. The differences in service were discussed as well as possible reasons for the appeal.

Added agenda items;

1. Don made a motion that he be enabled to apply for funding from a special transportation projects grant, to do survey and engineering work on a plan to improve the safety of the bus parking and student load-unload area in front of the high school . Betty seconded. Vote 3 on the talley , 4 yes votes

2. Jason made a motion to approve renewal of the P.O. box for another year. Don seconded, and Betty was given the form and agreed to take care of the payment. Vote #4 on the talley, 4 yes votes

3. Don brought up the idea of trying to get a drop box placed in Colton for collecting ballots at election time. Location and security were discussed and Jason made a motion that we request this service. Betty seconded, Vote #5 on the talley, 4 yes votes.

4. Don mentioned the annual Elwood picnic on the second Sunday in August and invited all to attend.
