2. Public Comments/Participation

3. Update-Ellen Rogalin
  - State Global Warming Commission is holding a workshop around the state to gather the input from the public how ways to coordinate state and local efforts to reduce green house gas emissions and make sure the state meets its climate goals. 4. TSP- Ellen Rogalin

- The public survey for TSP went to a couple different locations, the Molalla CPO and the County Fair. The issue that seemed to be the most concern for everyone was road conditions. The lowest was health concerns and commercial freight.
- The meeting will be held October 13 from 6pm-7:30 in the Development Services Building.
- CCI, BCC, CPO's, Hamlets and Villages and others are all invited to attend.
- An advisory board is being created for the TSP which will meet six times over the course of two years. The purpose of the PAC is to advise the community and gather concerns and issues related to the future of transportation systems.
- North Fork project around Dickey Prairie around Molalla has had a lot of extra effort put into it to reduce the high levels of dirt and dust. The community is pleased with these actions.

5. Clackamas County Fair- Barbara Smolak

Everyone participated and went to the fair. Many people stated they felt attendance was down a little from years past along with the number of booths.
