Notice is hereby given that Clackamas County, through its Board of County Commissioners, will receive sealed proposals until 5:00 PM, July 27, 2009, in the Office of the Purchasing Manager, 2051 Kaen Road, Oregon City, Oregon 97045 to provide:

### **RECREATIONAL SERVICES FOR MINORITY YOUTH**

as per specifications available at Clackamas County Purchasing, 2051 Kaen Road, Oregon City, Oregon. No proposals will be received or considered after that time. Each proposal must contain a statement as to whether the vendor is a resident vendor, as defined in ORS 279A.120. The bidder is not required to be licensed under ORS 468.883. No bid for construction contracts will be received or considered by the County unless the respondent is registered with the Construction Contractors Board or licensed by the State Landscape Contractors Board as required by ORS 671.530.

Clackamas County Juvenile Department's (CCJD) is seeking a qualified local non-profit agency to provide recreational services to juveniles in the Rowe Middle School area. This project is funded by a grant; the funding level is \$40,000.

CCJD intends to contract with a local non-profit agency to implement activities weekends during the school year and throughout summer months to increase protective factors and reduce risk of juvenile system involvement.

In the award of the contract, the Board of County Commissioners will consider the element of time, will accept the proposal or proposals which in their estimation will best serve the interests of Clackamas County and will reserve the right to award the contract to the contractor whose proposal shall be best for the public good.
