

INVITATION TO BID

Notice is hereby given that Clackamas County, through its Board of Commissioners, will open sealed bids on Thursday February 16, 2012 at 2:00 PM PST in the Office of the Purchasing Manager, 2051 Kaen Road, Oregon City, OR 97045 for the:

REPLACEMENT OF SIX (6) ROOF TOP UNITS AT THE CLACKAMAS COUNTY STEWART COMMUNITY CENTER

as per specifications available at Clackamas County Purchasing, 2051 Kaen Road, Oregon City, OR 97045 . No proposals will be received or considered after that time.

Clackamas County is requesting bids from qualified contractors to remove and replace six roof top units at the Clackamas County Stewart Community Center located in Oregon City, OR. This is an American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funded project and as such must meet the requirements spelled out in that act. The project is subject to both Davis Bacon wages and Oregon Prevailing wages (BOLI wage rates). Contractors and subcontractors must be registered with and have provided bonds to the Oregon Construction Contractors Board.

A **MANDATORY** on-site pre-bid conference is scheduled on Monday February 6 at 8:30 AM at the Clackamas County Stewart Community Center located at 1002 Library Court in Oregon City. Interested Bidders must be present and sign in to be eligible to submit bids for this project.

Each proposal must contain a statement as to whether the vendor is a resident vendor, as defined in ORS 279A.120. The Contractor or sub contractor **is not** required to be licensed under ORS 468A.720. This **is** a public work contract subject to ORS 279C.800 to 279C.870 **or** if applicable, the federal prevailing rate of wage required under the Davis-Bacon Act (40 U.S.C. 276a).

Sealed bids are to be sent to Lane Miller- Purchasing Manager, Clackamas County Purchasing, 2051 Kaen Road, Oregon City, OR 97045, telephone (503) 742-5444. The Clackamas County Board of County Commissioners may reject any bids not in compliance with all prescribed public bidding procedures and requirements, and may reject for good cause any or all proposals upon a finding that it is in the public interest to do so. The County may waive any and all informalities in the public interest.
