

REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

Notice is hereby given that Clackamas County, through its Board of County Commissioners, is soliciting statements of qualifications and proposals from interested firms or teams to provide consulting engineering services for the

REPLACEMENT OF THE NORTH FORK MOLALLA (DICKY PRAIRIE ROAD) BRIDGE

Proposers responding to this request will be evaluated on several factors, including but not limited to fee, qualifications, project approach, and communication.

Clackamas County is seeking the services of a qualified consultant to prepare roadway and structure design plans, specifications, cost estimates, and right-of-way appraisals and acquisitions for the replacement of the bridge structure.

A full description of the team's qualifications must be submitted to the County by **4:00 PM, June 3, 2009**. Statements received after the time and date specified will not be accepted. The submitted qualifications will be reviewed and scored by the Selection Committee. Points will be awarded based on the relative merit of the information provided in response to the solicitation. The highest rated response in each area will be given the highest number of points available. The highest scoring teams will be notified and invited to submit a technical design and price proposal. The County intends to invite at least three proposers, however the County reserves the right to increase or decrease the number of proposers at its sole discretion.

This **is not** a public works contract subject to ORS 279.348 to 279.380 or the Davis-Bacon Act (40 U.S.C. 276a).

Each proposal must contain a statement as to whether the vendor is a resident vendor, as defined in ORS 279A.120. The contractor or sub contractor is required to be licensed under ORS 468A.720.

Proposal packets will be available at Clackamas County Purchasing, Clackamas County Public Services Building, 2051 Kaen Road, Oregon City, OR 97045, phone 503-742-5444. Sealed qualification and proposal responses are to be sent to Lane Miller – Purchasing Manager at the Kaen Road address.

The Clackamas County Board of County Commissioners reserves the right to reject any and all proposals not in compliance with all prescribed public bidding procedures and requirements, reject any and all proposals upon the finding that it is in the public interest to do so, and waive any and all informalities.
