1. Chair Andersen called the meeting to order at 7:04pm. The November 16, 2010 minutes were then approved.
2. DTD Update – Ellen Rogalin
  - Discussed the closure of the bridge between West Linn and Oregon City for the next two years. Ellen pointed out that this is not a County project or a County bridge, it is an ODOT bridge and ODOT project.
  - Passed out information about the vehicle registration fee and frequently asked questions. These funds go towards the Sellwood Bridge project.
  - Ellen mentioned that Rolling Hills Community Church has withdrawn its request for a Zone of Benefits from the County.
3. Hamlets and Villages Update – Chris Roth
  - Stafford had an election on November 10<sup>th</sup> with 270 people who voted in the election.
  - Beavercreek had a meeting on November 17<sup>th</sup>.
  - The Villages at Mt. Hood will have a training session in January. Dan Chandler and Chris Roth will be there speaking on diversity and harassment. This will be a prototype for doing a diversity and sexual harassment presentation for all the Hamlets.
  - Nothing happening in Mulino or Molalla.

#### 4. Staff Update- Barbara Smolak

- The CPO Leaders Meeting is scheduled for January 31, 2011 which is a Monday. The format will be different than usual. This meeting will be on Code Enforcement and Code Compliance and it will be a work session. People attending will actually have the opportunity to give their input at the meeting. The anticipation is there will be a good turnout. Amy Cleary will be facilitating the Leaders Meeting.
- CCI now has five members since Chris Welling resigned a few months ago because of other obligations and Leah's term expired earlier in the year. A letter was sent to Leah thanking her for her years of service with CCI and that her input would be missed. Recruitment for CCI positions will begin sometime after the new year.
- A Domestic Violence Awareness Coordinator has joined Clackamas County a few months ago and her name is Christina Bondurant. Christina would like to get out into the public and speak on domestic violence and awareness. She has been invited to speak at the January CCI meeting.
- A Government Affairs Manager will be doing the County's work at the State Legislature. He began about a month ago and had a study session with the BCC to fill them in on what he plans on working on for the County. He will possibly be at a CCI meeting or CPO meeting during the coming year.
