Web Based Communications Technology Services

As per specifications available at Clackamas County Purchasing, 2051 Kaen Road, Oregon City, Oregon, office hours 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM Monday through Thursday. No proposals will be received or considered after that time. Each proposal must contain a statement as to whether the vendor is a resident vendor, as defined in ORS 279A.120. The bidder is not required to be licensed under ORS 468.883. No bid for construction contracts will be received or considered by the County unless the respondent is registered with the Construction Contractors Board or licensed by the State Landscape Contractors Board as required by ORS 671.530.

Clackamas County is seeking the services of an independent contractor to work closely with its Public and Government Affairs (PGA) department to assist in improving and enhancing two-way communication between citizens and the County via web-based technologies.

This **is not** a public works contract subject to ORS 279C.800 through 279C.870. the Davis Bacon Act (40 U.S.C. 276a).

In the award of the contract, the Board of County Commissioners will consider the element of time, will accept the proposal or proposals which in their estimation will best serve the interests of Clackamas County and will reserve the right to award the contract to the contractor whose proposal shall be best for the public good.
